Illinois Poultry Import Requirements:

All poultry entering Illinois for any reason except immediate slaughter are required to obtain an entry permit prior to entry. Permits are issued by calling **217-782-4944** and are issued 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

The permit number should be recorded on VS form 9-2 or 9-3, or carried separately and must be available upon request by representatives of the Illinois Department of Agriculture.

New this year: If you plan to attend the banquet (all you can eat buffet) you will need to pay for it at the time of show entries.



Show Guidelines:

- ◆ The Illini Poultry Club reserves the right to reject any or all entries.
- ◆ **ONLY** the judges and their clerk shall be allowed in the aisles or permitted to talk to the judge during judging. PLEASE be respectful and wait until the judge has time to answer any questions.
- ◆ Any bird showing signs of illness will be removed from the poultry buildings (show or swap) by the show superintendent.
- ◆ A display will consist of at least one each of cock, hen, cockerel, pullet, and trio (young or old) of the same variety. Waterfowl displays are cock, hen, cockerel, pullet, and 3 other of the same breed.
- ◆ Cockerels and pullets shall be under one year of age.
- ◆ Feed and water will be provided. Showmen must care for their own birds.
- ◆ IPC will not be held responsible for specials offered by any person or clubs. All winner(s) names will be sent to the Club responsible.
- ◆ If you wish to donate an award please send it with at the time of entry so that the winner may receive it at the awards ceremony. Thank you for your donation.
- ◆ IPC or its officials will not be held responsible for the loss, sickness, or injury to any bird on the show grounds. NOR will we be held responsible for caring for any birds left behind after coop out. (The local 4-Hers will appreciate your donation.)
- ◆ Official APA & ABA rules shall apply.
- ◆ **ALL** poultry shall remain in their designated coops until release from the show superintendant. **ANY** birds removed early without permission will forfeit **ALL** awards and points.
- ◆ Any person winning a spot on champion row is responsible for taking their bird up to champion row and placing it in the appropriate cage.
- ◆ Any case not provided for in these rules will be referred to the show officials and their decision shall be **FINAL**.
- ◆ The judges will not award 1st place to a bird not worthy of the placement due to lack of competition.
- ◆ **Waterfowl:** geese will be cooped in pairs, unless otherwise requested on the entry form.
- ◆ **Exhibitor's Table:** Upon arriving at the show please check in at the exhibitor's table to receive your exhibitor number and exhibitor list. There are separate tables for OPEN and JUNIOR.
- ◆ **Banquet:** There will be a banquet held after the APA General Meeting (6:00 pm) on Saturday evening. Tickets are \$12.00 per person and must be ordered with your entry. This year's banquet is an all you can eat buffet (chicken & ham, with several side dishes) with desert included. One soft drink ticket will be included with your meal. A cash bar will be open at the VFW starting at 5:00 p.m.

New this year: If you plan to attend the banquet (all you can eat buffet) you will need to pay for it at the time of show entries.

 - ◆Will have to demonstrate applied poultry knowledge.
 - ◆Will be asked to handle birds other than the one brought to the class.
 - ◆Will be judged on ability to communicate with judge and peers.
 - ◆Class will begin promptly at 8:00 AM.
 - ◆Showmen will be observed throughout the day for the qualities that demonstrate the skills and attitude of an exceptional showman.
 - ◆Questions will range from exhibition, history, basic production, general avian knowledge, anatomy and physiology, practical application, legal, health and nutrition, and economics.
